Psychiatry: Psychiatric evaluations and medication management services by board certified/eligible providers.

Outpatient Therapy: Therapy in both individual and group settings, for those with a mental health, substance use or co-occurring diagnosis. Outpatient Therapy is provided at the Ortiz, Evans and Cape Coral Campuses. If refills or medication management for OPP is needed, call the nursing line at 791-1518.

Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT): Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) is for Opioid and Alcohol Use Disorders and includes the use of medication, along with counseling and other supports, to help patients achieve a drug-free lifestyle.

Forensic Diversion: Seeks to divert individuals with serious mental illnesses (including those with co-occurring substance use disorders) from unnecessary institutionalization and/or criminalization.

Day Treatment Services / Extended Day Treatment: Available to patients who have a sober supportive environment in which to reside during their treatment. This is a less expensive alternative to Residential Treatment with the same benefit for patients requiring additional structure.

Case Management: Provided for individuals 18 and older who have serious mental health, substance use or co-occurring disorders to assist in linking to community resources and coordinating additional services.

Maternal Assistance Program (MAP): MAP assists women who are pregnant or are within 12 months post-partum. If eligible, you can receive free substance use treatment and incidental items (therapy, psychiatric, residential treatment, baby items).

TLC (Transitional Living Center): 20-bed co-ed substance use residential treatment program for adults utilizing an intensive, therapeutic and educational program, emphasizing individualized treatment, family and other interpersonal relations.

Transitional Care: SalusCare operates a 16-bed women's transitional care program and a 14-bed men's transitional care program on its Transitional Living Campus. This longer-term adult residential program allows recovering individuals an opportunity to live in a home-like environment while working or enrolling in school and receiving substance use and mental health treatment. Most residents stay 4 to 6 months, depending on their needs. Residents are required to pay a portion of their income to live in the halfway housing and to meet other income requirements.

Recovery Residences (SalusCare Place): SalusCare Place is a Recovery Residence where individuals with substance use issues and addiction can find a "recovery family." Detoxification Services: Inpatient 29-bed facility operating 24/7 under the direction of a physician, and serves adults undergoing acute withdrawal from alcohol and/or drugs. No appointment is necessary. Duration of care ranges from 4 to 8 days, depending upon severity of withdrawal symptoms. Our facility is located near a major hospital, which is available for any critical physical complications. Located at the Evans Campus.

Psychiatry: Psychiatric evaluations and medication management services by board certified/eligible providers.

Outpatient Therapy: Therapy in individual, family and group settings, for those with a mental health, substance use or co-occurring diagnosis. Outpatient Therapy is provided at the Ortiz, Evans and Cape Coral Campuses.

Children's Case Management: Provided for children, and their families, diagnosed with a serious emotional disturbance to assist in linking to community resources and coordination of mental health services.

Residential Treatment: Provides treatment for males and females ages 13 – 17 with a substance use diagnosis at our Vince Smith Campus. Our therapeutic environment provides 24-hour supervision in a structured setting. Education is provided through the Lee County School District in our in-house classroom for grades 7-12. GED options are available for those in need. The residential program operates year round with a typical length of stay of four months.

Therapeutic Behavioral On-Site Services (TBOS): TBOS is a voluntary service that provides evidence-based mental health services to children and their families. It includes therapy for the individual child and the family to teach problem-solving skills, behavior strategies, anger management skills, social skills training and parenting skills. Service is provided in the community or within the family home. TBOS is a short-term service lasting three to six months.

Emergency Services / Crisis Stabilization Unit: Provides secure, inpatient psychiatric stabilization for youth requiring the highest level of care and are at risk of harming themselves or others. Located at SalusCare's Colonial Campus.

Juvenile Addiction Receiving Facility (JARF): The JARF offers voluntary and involuntary substance use services to children and teens, located at SalusCare's Colonial Campus.
